Language Requirements	We recommend that exchange students have at least Level 3 of TOPIK (Test of Proficiency in Korean) or equivalent to Korean fluency.

Application Guidelines	Applications must be submitted via email by coordinator or professor of your home institution.
Online Interview	After we receive the applications materials from your home institution, we will hold an interview with applicants via ZOOM.
